Intro	I added a paragraph about recent efforts to pursue AACSB accreditation, which will tie to several plans in the review.
2	Reversed Goals and Objectives.
3	I added examples to the table to show what types of assessment are available. Also expanded later sections to update Alumni survey status and talk to GPA charts. Note that the GPA data is included here because AACSB considers this assessment.
7	I was just informed that we can hire a one-year emergency position in management for next year. I've noted this in this section.
8	I expanded on some of the information; added a copy of the recommended course sequence from the catalog; added a copy of the Registration Checklist provided to each student.
9	I added a "Challenges" section that talks to the tables.
10	Added a paragraph on past attempts to build an internship program and have a senior celebration. Added a "Plans" section that addresses the need for an internship program and advisory board (both AACSB requirements), as well as our recent experiment with Facebook.
13	I expanded the consequences of being housed in Seabury – how it has delayed efforts toward a permanent dean and AACSB accreditation.
14	Updated alumni survey status: 22 of 465 returned and sent for coding and analysis. And, I added a chart that I inadvertently missed when I did the electronic version of the report. It is a summary of the Student Surveys.
