

## Southern Connecticut State University Harry and Mary Inglese Endowed Memorial Scholarship

The Harry and Mary Inglese Endowed Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2003 in memory of Harry and Mary Inglese by members of both the Inglese and Nicolau families who are graduates of SCSU.

Inglese family members include Vincent L. Inglese '54, son of Harry and Mary, his wife, Nancy Daly Inglese '56 and their daughter Catherine M. Inglese '80. Nicolau family members are Anthero (Nick) Nicolau '57 and Eleanor Weiss Nicolau '54.

The Inglese family has achieved success in sports and academics as Southern students and alumni. Vincent Inglese is a 1992 inductee into the SCSU Hall of Fame for his accomplishments in playing basketball while attending Southern. Nancy Daly Inglese, after graduation, became an educator in the Wallingford School system along with Vincent. Their five children were all educated in the Wallingford Public School System. Catherine Inglese is a 1992 SCSU Hall of Fame inductee in both basketball and softball. Her success as a Head Coach of a Division -I basketball team highlights her continued contributions to academics and athletics at the collegiate level.

Nick Nicolau was inducted into the 1995 SCSU Football Hall of Fame. He was also the first SCSU alumnus hired as a head coach in collegiate football. He lived with Harry and Mary Inglese during his studies at SCSU. After graduating he went on to earn a doctorate degree in Physical education and had highly successful careers in football as both a collegiate and NFL coach. Eleanor Nicolau was an honored educator and is a dedicated mother.

### Scholarship Criteria:

1. The student must be a full time undergraduate as defined by the University.
2. The student must be a member of a Men's or Women's Varsity athletic team.
3. The student recipient must be of high academic standing.
4. The student recipient must be a graduate of the Wallingford Public School system.
