

Auditing a Course:

With instructor and advisor permission, a course may be taken as an audit (no grade assigned - no influence on grade point average). In the Department, permission to audit is generally granted if a student has had similar course material in a course taken at another institution, or if the student wishes to gain information in a course which is not part of his/her planned program. Please note: A student who audits is expected to attend classes on a regular basis and be listed on the course roster as an auditing student. Students must pay the regular registration price for the course.
