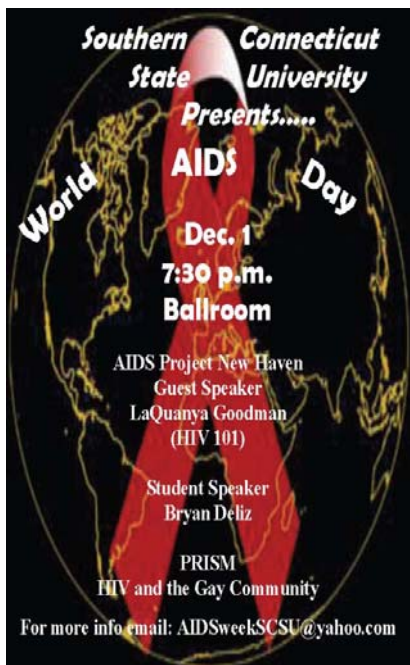


AIDS AWARENESS WEEK @ SCSU

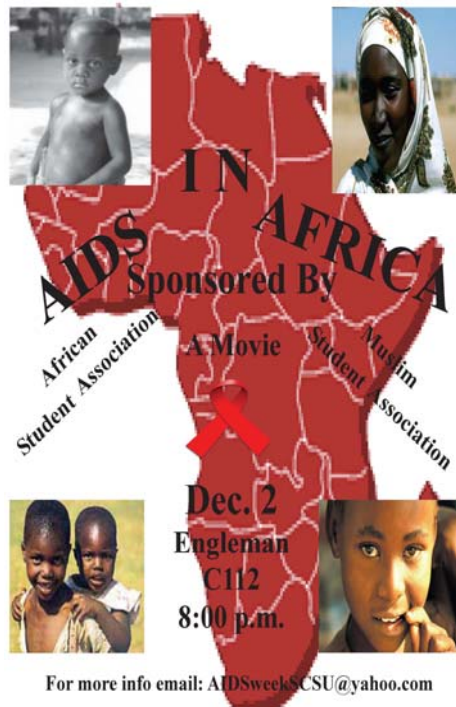
