

PLANNING FOR USE OF ADAPTIVE TECHNOLOGY OR ALTERNATE FORMATS IN THE CLASSROOM

Students who require assistive technology or alternate formats to participate in courses may need training on the technology or may need to work with the DRC and Center for Adaptive Technology to implement these accommodations prior to the start of the semester. Training is available by appointment at the Center for Adaptive Technology (CAT). Early planning is essential, as training may take up to a full semester, depending upon the technology needed. Students who anticipate a need for assistive technology and/or alternate formats should notify the DRC and Center for Adaptive Technology as soon as possible.
