Dr. Marcelo M. Suárez-Orozco's work is interdisciplinary, comparative, and longitudinal. His basic research is on conceptual and empirical problems in the areas of cultural psychology and psychological anthropology with a focus on the study of immigration and globalization. He is author of numerous scholarly essays, books, and edited volumes including: *Globalization: Culture and Education in the New Millennium* (co-edited with Desirée Qin-Hilliard, University of California Press, 2004), *Latinos: Remaking America* (co-edited with Mariela Paez, University of California Press, 2002), and *Children of Immigration* (co-authored with Carola Suarez-Orozco, Harvard University Press, 2001).
