**1. Review/Updates of 2006 Projects**

- **Moore Field House – Locker Rooms**

Initial bids were too high so the project will be rebid with a reduced scope. Bidding process should take 4 – 6 weeks.

**2. Review/Updates of 2007/08 Projects**

- **Wintergreen Space Study**

On hold due to funding.

- **Parking Lot 7**

System Office will initiate CHEFA bond issue in February.

- **University Police – Dispatch Area**

Project is ready for design.

- **Communication Department – Earl Hall**

On hold due to funding.

- **Business School**

University has been notified that this project is on the agenda for the next Bond Commission meeting (rescheduled for February 2)

**3. Review/Updates of 2008/09 Projects**

- **Jennings Biology Department – Convert Jennings 244**

Project is under construction.

- **Earl Hall Entrance**

On hold due to funding – it is expected that there may be some funding available from the Earl Hall Mechanical and Electrical upgrade project since it came in under bid.

- **Pelz – Athletics Office**

Project is under construction.

- **Asbestos Abatement/Installation of New Vinyl Flooring in Jennings Hall**

Completed on time and on budget.

- Various Campus Wide Improvement Projects:
  - **Music Department EN B 014**  
Project is under construction and is anticipated to be completed by March.
  - **Assistant Athletic Director's Office – Moore Field House**  
Project is under construction.
  - **Green House Demolition**  
Project complete.
  - **Student Center Space Reallocation- Combine Room 326 and 324**  
Project was cancelled.
  
- **New Academic Science Building – Program Phase**  
Program has been completed – awaiting final sign off/approval from University and then will move into the design phase.
  
- **Classroom Inventory**  
Inventory is complete.
  
- **Foundations Area Dust Collection System**  
On hold due to funding – it is expected that there may be some funding available from the Earl Hall mechanical and Electrical upgrade project since it came in under bid.
  
- **Disaster Recovery Data Center**  
Project is on hold – awaiting approval from CHEFA.
  
- **Design/Renovations to Housing Administrative Offices**  
Project is in the design phase.

#### 5. Other New Requests

- **Engleman Hall B 212 – Request to install high-speed network cabling**  
Request has been cancelled.
  
- **Crescent Street Entrance**  
Assuming that the State Bond Commission will approve funding for the new school of business this will no longer be an issue.
