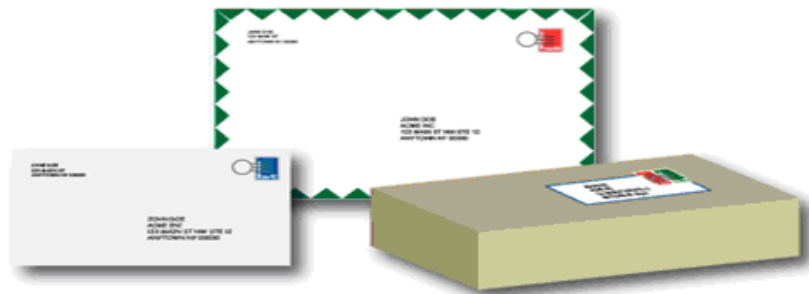


New Postal Rates Coming May 12, 2008

POSTAL INCREASE set for May 12, 2008

The U.S. Postal Service will soon adjust prices for postal rates and mailing services. Effective May 12, 2008, the following new rates will apply:

New Rates:

✉ First-Class Mail Letter (1 oz.).....	\$0.42
✉ First-Class Mail Letter (2 oz.)	\$0.59
✉ Postcard	\$0.27
✉ First-Class Mail large envelope (2 oz.).....	\$1.00
✉ Certified Mail	\$2.70
✉ First-Class Mail International letter to Canada and Mexico (1 oz.)	\$0.72
✉ First-Class Mail International letter to all other countries (1 oz.)	\$0.94
