

UNIVERSITY SPACE COMMITTEE

The University Space Committee advises and makes recommendations to the President concerning the utilization and improvement of University spaces in accordance with the Facilities Master Plan and the mission of the University.

Purpose

The committee's purpose is to review and update the facilities inventory of existing available space and how that space is assigned, to analyze the space needs of all elements of the University community, to advise the President on how existing space can be better utilized and to assist in identifying the future space requirements of the University based on student enrollments.

Membership

The committee consists of seven members. The three University vice presidents serve *ex officio*. Three members are appointed by the instructional faculty, two are appointed by the administrative faculty and one is appointed by the classified staff.

Meetings

Meetings are generally held monthly from September through June. Special meetings may be called by the President, the chairperson or any three members of the committee as needed.
