

Year Round Pell Grant (Additional Pell Grant for Summer 2018)

The U.S. Department of Education has announced that students who received a Pell Grant for the 2017-2018 year may be eligible to receive additional Pell Grant funds for summer 2018. Students must register and maintain a minimum of six (6) credits during one or more of the summer sessions. To apply for summer financial aid, complete the Summer 2018 Financial Aid Application and submit it to the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships.

It is important to note that this change will not result in extra Pell Grant funds being awarded to a student over the course of their undergraduate enrollment. The maximum time frame that eligible students may receive the Pell Grant is for twelve (12) full-time semesters. In the past, a full-time student could only receive two disbursements per year. Now the student will be able to receive up to three (3) Pell Grant disbursements in one academic year (fall, spring and summer).

If the PELL LEU is 600% or over, the student will not be eligible for additional Pell Grant funds. If the PELL LEU is close to 600%, the student will be eligible for the remaining balance.

Students who drop or withdraw from a summer course(s) and fall below the minimum six (6) credit threshold or the class is canceled by the university, the Pell Grant will be canceled and the student will be responsible to pay the outstanding university charges.

Additional Pell Grant funds are not enough to cover university expenses. Therefore, students need to budget ahead and have alternative funding available to help pay for the entire summer educational expenses.
