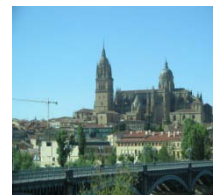
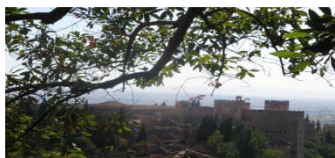

The following documents must be received in the SPAR office before the leading faculty member(s) of each respective trip will be informed of your formal intent:

- Two letters of recommendation
- One unofficial transcript (requested from the Office of Registrar)
- Application form (specific to each different program)

Upon the receipt of these materials, a SPAR employee will contact the program director to inform s/he that you will be contacting them to set up an interview or meeting. Once the program director has accepted you into the program, you will need to make an appointment to see Ms. Michelle Pavlik (SPAR, PAVLIK1@southernct.edu, 392.5454). You will be given a risk-management packet (included are legal waivers, medical forms, information about general and country specific information) that **must** be completed prior to the end of the Spring semester.
