**ADMISSION PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS**

A1. **Request original transcripts from all college experiences.**

2. **Submit Application for Admission to Graduate Study.** You may submit a hard copy or submit application online at southernct.edu.

3. **Submit three reference forms** (attached.) Be sure to sign all reference forms.

4. **Submit Marriage and Family Therapy Program Application**

5. **Submit a resume**

6. **A personal interview** is required.

B1. The university allows students to register for up to 9 credits before a planned program is required. However there is no assurance that courses taken prior to matriculation will be credited toward program requirements.

C1. Consideration of matriculation status is dependent on completion of all materials outlined in section A above.

D1. Program Practicum and Internship

2. The practicum sequence may be begun after completion of MFT 597, 598, 505, and runs 10 hours per week.

3. Candidates should expect to commit at least two calendar years, including summers, to completing program requirements.

4. Students must complete 500 clinical contact hours to complete the program.
