

Greek Life Council By-laws
Voted and approved on May 2, 2008

Shown below are rules and regulations for Greek Life Council's Rush, Recruitment, and Promotions.

Greek Life Council promotions will indicate dates of the Club Fair and of the Greek Fair. A Greek Fair or other type of GLC promotional event should be held the second week of the semester. The date will be decided on by GLC.

Individual organization promotions will start on the first day of classes, no earlier than 9:00 am.

When posting promotional items, each organization must follow the University Policy. In addition posters can be no larger than 22" x 28", which is the size of a poster board. Promotional items must not take up more than one quarter the size of the bulletin board. Each organization must be mindful of other organizations promotional items as well. We must be respectful and not over power each other. All promotional materials advertising rush events will be taken down at the close of rush.

Recruitment- activities hosted by sororities and fraternities designed to help non-members and member become acquainted, after which interested students may be offered an invitation to membership. Recruitment can be active and/or passive and is continued throughout the year.

Formal Rush- a sorority or fraternity must abide but the policy set forth by the GLC with a predetermined open and close rush period followed by an educational process.

Formal Rush is a three to four week period of time that begins with the Greek Fair or with a date that will be decided by the Council, no later than May 1st for the following fall semester and December 1st for the following spring semester.

Open Rush- a sorority or fraternity must abide by the policy set forth by the GLC with an open rush period followed by a structured educational process where as new members are to be inducted by the end of the semester.

All organizations must submit a roster to the Office of Student Life at the beginning and the end of each semester. Dates will be decided on by the Office of Student Life.

Organizations taking part in Formal Rush must hand in a roster of all potential new members at the end of rush. The date will be set by the Office of Student Life and the Council. After this point **no potential new members can be added to the roster.**

Organizations taking part in Open Rush must hand in a roster 2 weeks prior to beginning the formal education process. Organizations will close the enrollment period after submitting the roster. The date will be set of the Office of Student Life and the Greek Life Council.

There will also be a Hazing workshop or meeting which will be mandatory for all potential new members and others as determined by the Council and/or the Office of Student Life.

Late submission of rosters will incur in a financial penalty. The exact amount will be set by GLC Executive Board.

All promotional items will be taken down by the end of the semester. This gives everyone a clean space to work with in the upcoming semester.

Any organization that does not adhere by the rules will be addressed by J-Board. Exceptions can be proposed (in writing) at least two weeks prior to the beginning of the semester and are to be voted on by the Council.
