

IN SUPPORT OF FULL-TIME, TENURE-TRACK HIRES

May 4, 2005/September 7, 2005

Whereas SCSU exists for the primary purpose of furthering academic excellence;

And whereas SCSU both in spirit and letter acknowledges the contributions of both full-time and part-time instructors;

And whereas there are contractual limits placed on part-time instruction;

And whereas SCSU is operating in excess of these limits;

And whereas full-time, tenure-track faculty are needed in all programs to develop curriculum and programs, advise students and student organizations, mentor theses, internships and independent studies; engage in scholarship, and participate in other university activities in order to fully meet the needs of SCSU students;

And whereas certain programs have become so dependent upon part-time instructors that student needs are compromised regarding the scheduling of both all-university courses and upper division program requirements;

Therefore, be it resolved that:

The SCSU administration secure a sufficient number of full-time, tenure-track faculty to comply with the CSU/AAUP-BOT Contract (Appendix G).
