

INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION---APPLICATION FOR ACCEPTANCE

1. You must attach a copy of your **transcript** (unofficial web version is acceptable) which includes all COMPLETED courses (and all TRANSFERRED courses, if applicable).
2. In order to be **Accepted**, you must have an overall QPR (GPA) of at least 2.50 or higher and have a grade of C or higher in psychology courses (and cognates for the Research Specialization). You must maintain the same standards in order to graduate as a psychology major.
A grade in a psychology course (or cognate) that is a C- or any D grade means that you must
 - retake the course and receive a grade of C or higher (the only option if the course is required for your program),
or
 - take another course from the same group of options (the deficient course will become a general elective).If you retake a course in which you received a grade of C- or lower, you will not receive credit for the retaken course but the grade in the retaken course will be counted in your QPR.
3. You should apply for Acceptance after you have COMPLETED 45 credits and before you have COMPLETED 60 credits. If you become a Psychology major after you have already completed 60 credits, you should apply for Acceptance as soon as possible.
4. If you transferred to Southern, you must complete one semester at Southern before you can apply for Acceptance. If you then have COMPLETED at least 45 total credits, then you should apply for Acceptance.
5. After completing your application and attaching your transcript, review your application with your advisor, obtain their endorsement and have your Advisor forward your application.
6. If you transfer credits to SCSU, please be aware of the following conditions.
 - Transfer students must complete at least 50% of the requirements for the major at SCSU.
 - In order for a transferred psychology course (or cognate for the Research Specialization) to be Accepted toward the major at SCSU, it must have received a grade of C or higher (indicated on the transcript as a grade of 'T1'). A psychology course (or cognate) transferred to SCSU with a grade below a C (indicated on the transcript as a grade of 'T2' or 'T3') can not be Accepted for the requirements in the major.
 - A Psychology course which transfers with prefix of 0 preceding the course number (e.g., PSY 0200) cannot be applied toward the major in Psychology but will count toward your elective credits.
