About the Fair

The Women & Girls' Fair is in conjunction Women and Girls of Color: History, Heritage, Heterogeneity" at Southern Connecticut State University. The fair will be open from 1:00 — 5:30 on Friday and 8:30 — 5:30 Saturday, April 16th and 17th, 2010 Vendors should arrive at least one hour before the fair opens each day to set up their table(s). The Fair will be held indoors. Exhibitors must have insurance, be responsible for their own exhibits, and accept all responsibility for loss or damage to their wares. Southern Connecticut State University (SCSU) and the Women's Studies Program will not be responsible for any theft, loss or damage to exhibits and/or merchandise. Exhibitors without insurance will be required to sign a waiver form.

Types of Exhibit Space

Vendors are offered one, six-foot table for the cost of the exhibit. An additional table will cost double. Vendors are responsible for the decoration and display at each table. Tables may be attended or unattended; this does not affect the price. All vendors are responsible for the setup and breakdown of their table. Any materials left behind will not be returned to the vendor and will be distributed to the campus or discarded.

Applying for vending space

To secure a vending space at the 2010 Women and Girls' Fair, please return the completed application form with the following:

Payment in the form of a check made out to **SCSU Women's Studies Program**.

Photocopy of insurance for your merchandise/organization.

Brochure and/or description of your products/organization.

Completed applications must be postmarked by March 15th for consideration. If your application is accepted, the fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable. A contract and map will be mailed to you upon your acceptance. If your application is not accepted, your check will be returned.
