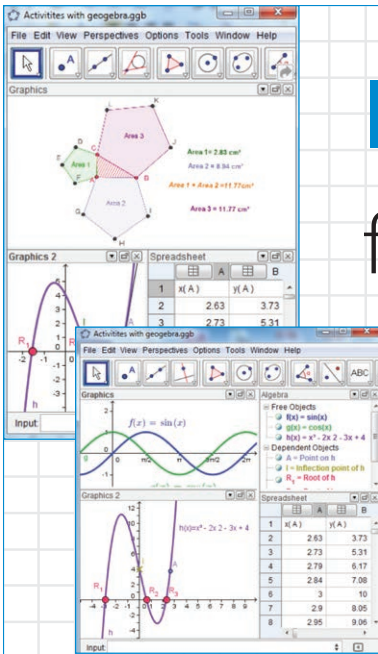


Introduction to GeoGebra for Secondary Teachers
