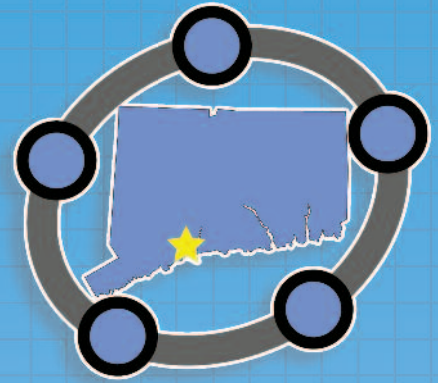


The Second Annual GeoGebra Conference OF SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT

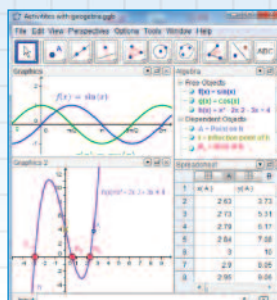
