

Advisement Worksheet for BSN College Admission Pathway Students

Using your degree evaluation, cross/check off the requirements below that you have successfully completed or are currently in. Then use the semester spaces to jot down your plan to fit in the remaining requirements starting with Nursing requirements (3-4 a semester) and filling in the rest with LEP/W requirements. 5 courses a semester keeps you on track without summer/winter courses. Bring your work to your advising meeting to discuss.

Common PreReqs (for those not placed directly into courses that require a certain level of proficiency. If not needed, check off.)

- MAT 100/P** - prereq to MAT 107, MAT 108 (MAT 100/P grade must be a C- or higher), PHY 103, & CHE 120
- ENG 110 or 119** (for bilingual students) – prereq to ENG 112 or 120 (for bilingual students)
- Language 101** – prereq to level 3 language

STEM Foundations for Nursing

7 of the following 11 nursing requirements need to be complete with a grade of a C+ or higher by the last winter before your Feb. 1st application deadline (usually sophomore year). All remaining will need to be completed with a grade of a C+ or higher by the end of the summer just before the nursing program begins should you be admitted.

Listed in recommended order (not required order):

Year 1

- ENG 112 or 120** *See common prereq info on ENG above
- MAT 107** *See common prereq info on MAT above
- PHY 103** *See common prereq info on MAT above
- BIO 200**

Year 2

- PSY 100**
- CHE 120** *See common prereq info on MAT above
- BIO 201** (need BIO 200 1st)
- MAT 108** *See common prereq info on MAT above
- PSY 219** (need PSY 100 1st)
- CHE 125** (Need CHE 120 1st; Also, 125 is only offered in spring/summer)
- BIO 120**

The 6 underlined courses are lab sciences. Two should be complete by the end of summer of the 1st year followed by two per semester the 2nd year. It is not recommended to take more than 2 lab sciences a semester.

LEP Tier Requirements

These are degree requirements that need to be completed before graduation, but most should be completed before beginning Nursing courses if admitted to the Nursing program. Not listed are the LEP requirements that overlap with nursing requirements already mentioned.

Tier 1

- First Year Experience (T1FY)** – INQ 101
- Critical Thinking (T1CT)** – Multiple Course Options
- Multilingual Communication (T1MC)** *see common prereq info on Language above; Also, discuss options with your advisor

Tier 2

- American Experience (T2AE)** – Multiple Course Options
 - Creative Drive (T2CD)** – Multiple Course Options
 - Cultural Expression (T2CE)** – Multiple Course Options
 - Global Awareness (T2GA)** – Multiple Course Options
 - Conflict & Consensus (T2CC)** – Multiple Course Options
 - Time & Place (T2TP)** – Multiple Course Options
- *Only 5 of the 6 Tier 2 reqs need to be complete for graduation

Writing Intensive Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, 3 are required by graduation. **ENG 112 is not a W course.** It is recommended (not required) to take 1 per semester 2nd year and then the 3rd later. You should be able to find W sections of Tier 2 courses, so you could fulfill 2 requirements with one course.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Students will be required to earn acceptance into the BSN program through a formal application process. Admission to the BSN program is competitive.

- The application cycle occurs **once per year**. The application is open from November 1st to February 1st of each year. Admitted students will begin nursing courses in the fall semester following the spring semester February 1st application deadline.
