In the retail environment, customers and coworkers focus on him as a young, gay man, and perpetuate forms of bigotry during the 2016 rise of Donald Trump. As a result of both spaces, Lacerenza experiences mental, emotional, and physical health issues. From the Valley, a Memoir not only portrays the dangers of remaining silent but also reveals injustice at both his college and his workplace.
