RE: ADDENDUM #3 RFP 22-SCSU-06 – Landscaping Services

Answers to Questions:

Q1. Historically, how much mulch was used for an annual contract:

A1. The University does not require a certain amount of mulch be used; the amount is left up to the Contractor. Contractors shall be responsible for mulching the areas requested by the University including the North Campus pathways behind Jess Dow Field.

Q2. Up to what height is the Contractor responsible for before it would be considered arborist work?

A2. The Contractor shall be responsible for tree cutting up to fifteen (15) feet. Above that, would be considered arborist work.

Q3. If the Contractor doesn't have the CT licenses for pesticides but the subcontractor does, is that ok?

A3. Yes. The company who has the license must be the ones to apply any pesticides.

Q4. Can the previous RFP for this work be made available to us for reference?

- Q4. The current contract was provided in Addendum #1. The Scope of Work from the previous RFP to this one is the same.
- Q5. Can you include the sign-in sheet from the pre-bid meeting?
- Q5. See attached.
- Q6. In the Addendum released on 4/7/22, the pricing schedule from 2015 was listed. In the current contract, and this 2022 bid, there is a clause to renegotiate price each year. Is the 2015 price schedule listed in the addendum, the actual pricing schedule that is being used in 2022?
- A6. There is an escalation clause in the current contract however, pricing has remained the same.

- Q7. We were told in the pre-bid meeting that there are specific areas we are not allowed to use loud equipment and apply pesticides. While walking through campus, the current vendor was applying fertilizer and crabgrass preventer with people around. Can you please confirm whether the Contractor is or is not allowed to fertilize these areas during high student traffic hours?
- A7. Yes, if it is scheduled to start early in the morning.
- Q8. Where is the current approved dumpsite for SCSU? Are there fees to dump at this site? Can the goose droppings be dumped there as well?
- A8. There is no dumping on SCSU's property. Removal and dumping would be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- Q9. Spring Clean-up We noticed on the walk through that the campus uses sand during the winter. Who is responsible for removing the sand from the campus? Is this an additional charge? Plow damage, is this an additional charge or will the plowing contractor repair the damage?
- A9. Sweeping of any winter materials and repairs of damages will be addressed by SCSU.

Q10. Irrigation:

How many Controllers/Systems? 15
Manufacturer of Controllers? Hunter

Zones per Controller/System? 7 units – 48 units; will vary per unit
Locations of Controllers? Various locations throughout buildings

Locations of Backflows and Mainline Valves? Depends on the location of the main water line As builds for each irrigation system?

Specs will be provided to the awarded contractor.

A10. Answers in RED.

Q11. Maps:

Map for mulch beds we would be responsible for? I there a historic mulch quantity that has been used yearly? Map for mowing areas we would be responsible for? When walking the campus on our own today, we noticed the current Contractor working in an area that was not mentioned to us on the walkthrough. Map for annual flower areas we would be responsible for? Quantities and varieties used historically? Map for Flight Control/Goose dropping pick up areas we would be responsible for? What equipment is being used to sweep the goose dropping currently?

A11. The map attached is currently the best map available. SCSU is working on larger maps to show planted trees and plant beds for all specified areas on campus. Mowing areas for the contractor and SCSU staff will be outlined as well. The University will work with the awarded Contractor to insure

Annual flowers will be handled by the contractor. We have used Inpatients 10 inch pots, red and white and mums for designated areas.

SCSU will address the goose droppings and decide if Flight Control is required. The contractor would be responsible for the application.
