

Beatrice H. Rockwell Scholarship

(2 awards)

Applicants: Secondary Education, Undergraduate

Scholarship criteria:

1. Recipient must be full-time student at the university seeking certification in high school teaching.
2. Recipient must be in his or her junior or senior year at university and accepted into the School of Education.
3. Recipient must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average for the preceding two years.
4. Recipient must produce evidence of a source of funds to pay the balance of the costs for the academic year.*
5. Application must be accompanied by a recommendation by a faculty member.

*Kindly note that this criterion will be determined by the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships

The special goal of the fund is to provide half-scholarships to a junior and senior (or both) who is pursuing a certification to teach in high school education.
