ARTICULATION AGREEMENT GATEWAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE &

SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

March 17, 2015

Gateway Community College and Southern Connecticut State University hereby establish the following articulation agreement regarding students who earn an Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree in Liberal Arts and Sciences from Gateway.

Representatives from both institutions met to compare each program's curriculum and identify options for transferability of credits from Gateway Community College to Southern Connecticut State University. The agreement outlined below was approved by the SCSU University Curriculum Forum on February 19, 2015.

This agreement guarantees the following: Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) Associate's Degree holders from Gateway will be exempt from SCSU Tier 1 and Tier 2 requirements of the Liberal Education Program at Southern, with the exception of Multilingual Communication, which may be completed at Gateway (if available) or at SCSU. Students must complete TAP-level Quantitative Reasoning and sciences courses in order to be eligible. Some majors require specific course(s) within the LEP. In such case(s), the required course(s) may be completed at Gateway (if available) or at SCSU.

Students who have graduated from Gateway Community College with an Associate in Arts degree in Liberal Arts and Sciences since May, 2011 are eligible.

This agreement will promote the transferability of credits for Gateway Community College graduates who pursue a four-year degree at Southern Connecticut State University.
