## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT GATEWAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DRUG AND ALCOHOL RECOVERY COUNSELOR PROGRAM

## SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

April 26, 2013

Gateway Community College and Southern Connecticut State University hereby establish the enclosed articulation agreement between the Gateway Community College Drug and Alcohol Recovery Counselor Program and the Department of Social Work Bachelor of Science Social Work Program at Southern Connecticut State University.

Program Coordinators for both institutions met on March 14, 2013 to compare each program's curriculum and identify options for transferability of credits from Gateway Community College to Southern Connecticut State University. The agreement outlined below was approved by the BSW Core and Faculty Committee in the Department of Social Work on April 16, 2013.

This agreement guarantees the following: If a student who has completed an Associate's Degree in the Drug and Alcohol Recovery Counselor Program at Gateway Community College is accepted to Southern Connecticut State University AND to the BSW Program (which has a separate admission procedure), AND is enrolled in the Liberal Education Program (LEP), DARC courses will fulfill the 18 credits of Social Work Major Cognate credits (with the exception of DARC internship courses). The agreement will take effect for students graduating from Gateway Community College effective May, 2013.

DARC courses that currently meet the criteria for Social Work Major Cognate credits include: DAR 101, 111, 112, 158, 213, and a choice of 114, 117, 119, or 220 as an elective. Since DAR 251 and 252 are the internship courses, those would be approved as elective credits.

This agreement will promote the transferability of credits for Gateway Community College graduates who pursue the Bachelor of Science degree in Social Work at Southern Connecticut State University.
