Student Homepage

On your student homepage, you will first see your Class Information tab. This is where any classes you are enrolled in for the term will appear. Below the ‘Make an Appointment’ button, you will also see a box that says ‘Upcoming Appointments’ which will show any appointments you have already scheduled and their dates and times.

<p>Academic Advising</p>	<p><i>See Academic Advising Center</i> Select this for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Help planning out and understanding your degree plan • Getting advice regarding university policies, program requirements, LEP requirements, withdrawing from a course, or other related questions • Learning about resources at Southern and beyond to help you succeed • If you were placed on warning or probation and need to understand more about how this impacts your course of study • Talking about the possibility of doing a study abroad program and/or internships within your program <p><i>Talk About Exploring Majors</i> Select the area of study that has the majors you would like to explore. You can also choose “All Majors” if you are unsure. Select this if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You are not sure you’re in the right major • You want to understand the difference between majors or concentrations • You want to talk about requirements for other majors • You want to talk about your future life/career goals and how different majors might prepare you to meet your goals
<p>Academic Success</p>	<p><i>Academic Success Coaching</i> Select this if you would like help identifying barriers to your academic success and help with creating action plans for overcoming those challenges. Professional and Peer Academic Success Coaches help students maximize their potential for academic success by supporting them and assisting them in the development of effective study strategies and behaviors.</p> <p><i>Bilingual Literacy Support</i> Select this for reading comprehension and writing fundamentals support for bilingual students. This service is especially helpful for English language learners.</p> <p><i>Course-Based Tutoring</i> Select this if you would like content support for a specific course that you are currently enrolled in. Tutors will help with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Developing ideas • Reviewing Course Material • Exam preparation

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improving skills and understanding • Understanding your mistakes <p><i>PALs (Peer Academic Leaders)</i> Select this if you are enrolled in a class that has been assigned a Peer Academic Leader. PALs sessions are designed to offer additional academic support for groups of students by integrating “what to learn” with “how to learn”.</p> <p><i>Elementary Ed Math Remediation (Referrals Only)</i> Select this if you have been referred by Professor Adam Goldberg for one on one support for students studying to take the PRAXIS Math exam.</p> <p><i>Writing Tutoring and Lab Support</i> Select this for one on one support in general writing, or for support in Chemistry and Biology courses specifically on content and the structure of lab reports.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Dean of Students Office</p>	<p><i>Meet with the Dean of Students Office</i> Select this option to meet with the Dean of Students office to discuss any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food Security • Housing • Clothing • Child Care • Mental Health, Counseling & Substance Abuse • More Services
<p style="text-align: center;">Disability Resource Center</p>	<p><i>Meet with a Disability Specialist</i> The DRC staff acts as a resource for students, faculty, staff and community members on issues of disability to ensure students’ full participation at Southern. They offer assistance with course selection and registration, as well as developing compensatory strategies such as time management, study skills, identifying strengths and weaknesses, etc.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Financial Literacy</p>	<p><i>Meet Lew Deluca</i> Select this if you would like to meet with Lew Deluca to discuss:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paying and Saving for College • Payment Plan Options • Financial Aid • Scholarship Opportunities • Federal Loan Repayment • Etc.

How to Schedule a General Appointment

To schedule an appointment using SSC Navigate, first sign into Navigate. You will then be brought to your homepage.

Below you will see an example on how to make an academic success appointment in the Academic Success Center for general writing tutoring.

Step 1: Select the ‘Make an Appointment’ button from your homepage.

Step 2: Select the type of appointment you are looking for from the drop-down menu. If you are unsure about which to select, please see the Care Units and Services table above, for a brief description of services found in each.

Step 6: Pick a staff member. If you have a specific person you wish to schedule the appointment with, select their name from the drop-down menu to see only their availability.

Canceling Appointments

If you scheduled an appointment and can no longer make the appointment time or date, you have the option to cancel the appointment. Do this as far in advanced as possible. Only cancel appointments if absolutely necessary.

To cancel the appointment, navigate to 'Manage Appointment' by finding the desired appointment (see above) and then clicking on it to view the details. Once you click on the appointment, the Manage Appointment action box will appear. In the bottom left hand corner of this box, you will see 'Cancel Appointment'. Select this option.
